
2018+ Jeep Wrangler JL Front Inner Fender Install Instructions

Please inspect all components before install

Tools Required: 3/8" Wrench, 1/8" Allen Wrech

- 1. For easier access to the work area the front wheels can be removed this step is optional and not 100% necessary.
- 2. Remove the factory plastic fender well by removing the factory plastic retainers that hold it into place
- 3. Install the mesh pieces onto all 4 aluminum inner fender panels (these will each have a unique shape corresponding to where they go)
 - a. Ensure that each bolt and nut is tight to avoid rattling, additionally it can be a good idea to run a bead of silicone between the aluminum panel and the mesh to isolate any kind of rattling.
- 4. Starting on either side, install the rear portion of the 2 piece inner fender to the Jeep by fastening the lower rearward holes with the 10/32 bolt and nut supplied in the kit. (The front portion of the inner fender should not be installed yet)





- 5. Make sure that the turn signal plug is plugged in now (you will not be able to access it once the front panel is installed)
- 6. Connect the front portion of the inner fender by installing the supplied bolts through the front panel and into the nut-serts preinstalled in the rear portion of the inner fender



7. Bolt the last bolt through the factory hole shown below



8. Using 2 of the 4 supplied plugs connect the inner fender through the factory frame holes shown in the photo below.



Repeat steps 1 through 8 on the opposite side. Tighten all hardware.
